ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE INFO:

- **ARRIVAL** and registration is from **3-5pm (EST)** on the first day of the session.
- **DEPARTURE** is at **10:30am (EST)** on the last day of the session. Feel free to join us for the 9:30am closing chapel session!
- If your church is providing transportation, check with them for all travel times.

BEFORE CAMP CHECKLIST:

Use this checklist to help you prepare for camp. Campers who have registered online, paid their balance in full, and have money in their store account, will be able to go through a **faster registration when they arrive at camp.**

Do these things one week prior to camp:

- Pay full balance
- Add money to store account
- Update online health form
- Order care package (optional)
- Pack for camp! (see packing list to right)

MEDICATION/HEALTH NEEDS:

- Pack any prescription medication in the original container. **All medication will be turned in at check-in to the camp health officer.**
- Please do not pack any over-the-counter medication as we keep a stock of those here at camp.
- Inhalers and epipens may be kept with your camper.
- Email our camp health officer at info@miraclecamp.com to let us know of any special needs or dietary conditions before your child arrives at camp.

SCHEDULE, ACTIVITIES, & MONEY:

- Tubing (\$3 per ride)
- Paintball (\$5 for 2 games) - **Jr/Sr High**
- Craft Shack (Free - \$10)
- Coffee shop (\$1 - \$5)
- Camp store (\$0.25-\$40)

PACKING LIST:

- Clothing for outside, the gym, and colder evenings
- Swimsuit (please use modesty), towel, and sunscreen
- Bible, notebook, and pen
- Bedding (i.e. sleeping bag, blanket, pillow, or twin-sized bed sheets)
- Flashlight and bug spray
- Towels, washcloth, soap, toothbrush, other toiletries
- Daily medication
- Tennis shoes and sandals
- Water bottle
- Money for the trip home
- **Do NOT bring:** items you don't want to lose (valuables) and things that can hurt people (knives, weapons, paintball guns, etc.)

A GUIDE TO ACCESSING YOUR PARENT PORTAL:

To access your online account, follow these simple steps:

1. Go to miraclecamp.com
2. Click on the “Manage Your Account” link on the righthand side of the screen
3. Sign in with your email and password
4. Click “View Registrations” on your Dashboard, then click on your camper’s name
5. Your screen should look like the image below

Callout boxes provide additional instructions:

- "Complete/Update your camper's Medical Form" points to the Health Form section.
- "Update cabinmate requests up to one week before camp" points to the Terms and Conditions section.
- "Order a care package for your camper with no shipping charge!" points to the Pre-Orders section.
- "Give relatives access to send emails or order care packages" points to the Manage Guests section.
- "Add money to your camper's store account and track their spending" points to the Store Account section.
- "Make any final payments or set up a recurring payment plan" points to the Make Payment section.

A FEW NOTES ABOUT YOUR CAMPER'S STORE ACCOUNT:

- We recommend adding \$40-\$60 to your camper's store account online to cover purchases and activities throughout the week.
- Any remaining balance will be returned to you the next week via credit card or check. You also have the option of donating the remaining balance to camp.
- You can check your camper's balance while camp is in session and add money to the account online.
- If your camper needs money for the trip home, please pack it separately so it does not get mixed in with the store account at camp.
- Campers receiving a scholarship may not have more than \$25 in their store account.
