

Michigan Family Experiences

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do I have to have a family to come to camp?

A: No, couples and even singles are welcome, but we are a generational camp and we want to provide a great place for all the members of your family to call home.

Q: What rules are there about being around other families?

A: We are constantly monitoring the guidelines in our state and the Center for Disease Control for best practices. As of now we are asking participants to practice social distancing from other families. We are not seeking to be judgmental either of people who are more worried or those who are less concerned but we have a responsibility to follow state and federal guidelines.

Q: Do I have to wear a mask everywhere I go?

A: We only ask that you wear a cloth or disposable mask if you could come in contact with another family or staff member. Example: If you are sitting out enjoying some beautiful Michigan weather and reading a book in the area around your cabin then no mask would be necessary. If you are walking the trails it would be a good idea to have it on in case you pass another family. Masks are required at any staffed activity.

Q: Can I opt out of a specific meal?

A: Yes, of course! If your family would prefer one of our campfire cooked options or if going into town for takeout is your preference on a certain night please let us know by 3pm on the previous day so our kitchen has an accurate count. Because meals are included in the overall price, opting out of a meal does not provide a discount.

Q: Do activities cost extra?

A: No, each family may participate in the activities scheduled by signing up upon arrival or by the day before at 3 pm. Each family may also pick 2 activities from the menu or enjoy the unstaffed activities without extra cost. There is a cost for the crafts in the craft shack.

Q: What is the housing arrangement for my family?

A: Each family gets exclusive use of the housing assigned. Each room or half of a cabin will only contain 1 family. It will be thoroughly cleaned in between uses. There will be lots of outdoor spaces to enjoy!

Q: Is there an age range for children?

A: No, we invite you to come as a couple or family and any age of children are welcome. This is really an event designed for those you have been staying at home with.

Q: Do I have to stay in one of your cabins or can I bring an RV?

A: We do have two RV spots with 20-30 amp 120v electric, fresh water, and sewer as well. The lodging fees are reduced for guests using the RV hookups.

Q: Are there any discounts available for this event?

A: Yes! We realize that this crisis has been hard for many families and we want to do our best to partner with you. We have cabins available at a lower rate. There is also a 10% discount for coming on weekdays instead of the weekend. Scholarships can be applied for online and will be evaluated on a case by case basis and will be first come first serve.
