ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE INFO

- **ARRIVAL** is from **3-5 pm (EST)** on the first day of the session.
- **NEW!** There will be a 12-minute parent info meeting with our Executive Director, Ross Adams. These meetings will be held at **3:30 and 4:15** in Oakwood Chapel.
- **DEPARTURE** is at **10:15 am (EST)** on the last day. Parents are welcome to come earlier at **9:15** to sit in on our last session!
- Please double check that the "Authorized Pick-Up List" on their camp registration is up-to-date. Whoever comes to pick up your child will need to show an ID.

BEFORE CAMP CHECKLIST

- Pay full balance
- Add money to store account
- Update online health form (call in to make changes)
- Order care package (optional)

MEDICATION/HEALTH NEEDS

- Pack any prescription medication in the original container. All medication will be turned in to the health office at check-in.
- Please do not pack any over-the-counter medication as we keep a stock of those here at camp.
- Rescue inhalers, EpiPens, and diabetic supplies may be kept with your camper. (please send a bag with your camper to carry these supplies with them throughout the week)
- Email our camp staff at info@miraclecamp.com to let us know of any special needs or dietary restrictions before your child arrives at camp.

- **Do NOT bring:** items you don't want to lose (valuables, electronics, cell phones) and things that can hurt people (knives, weapons, paintball guns, etc.)

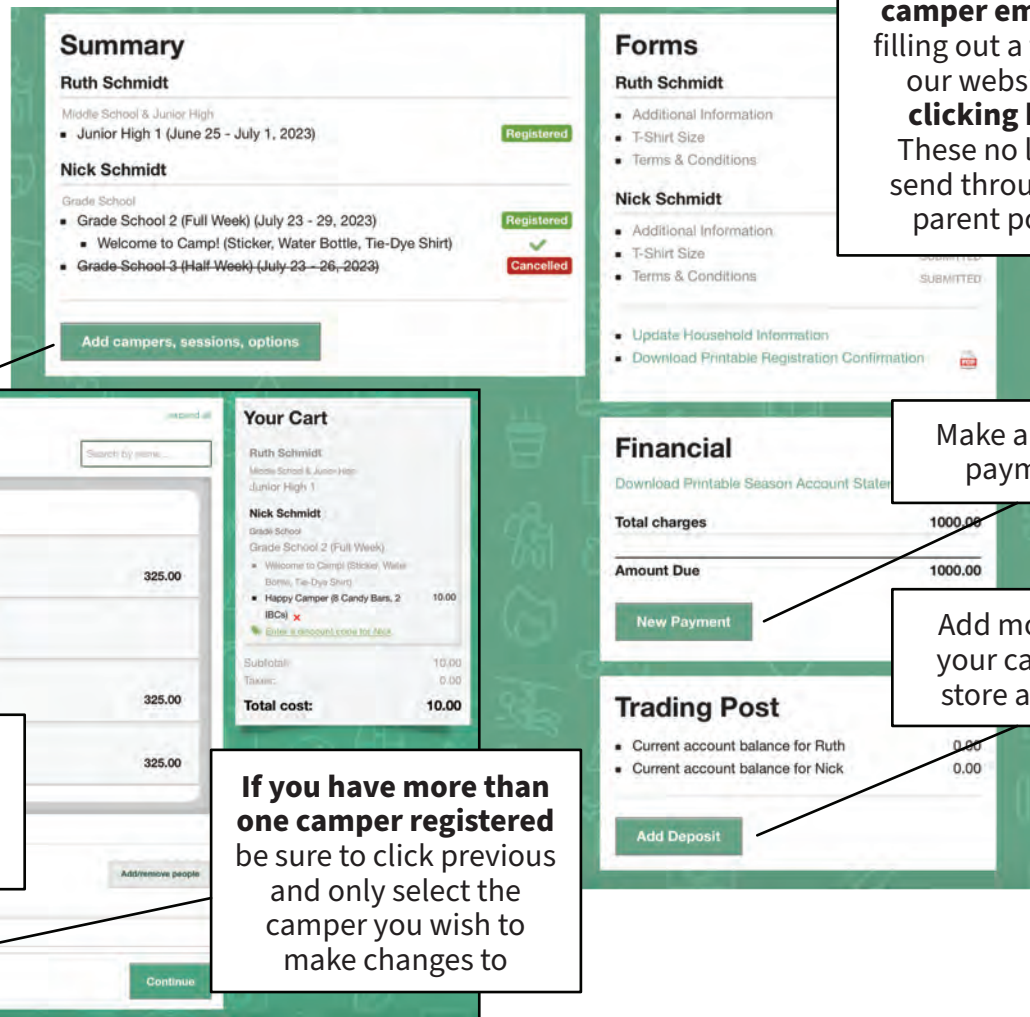
ACCESSING YOUR PARENT PORTAL

To access your online account, follow these simple steps:

- Go to miraclecamp.com
- Click on the person icon in the top right corner
- Sign in with your email and password
- Under “View My Submitted Registrations” click “View Details” on your camper’s registration
- Your screen should look like the image below:

A FEW NOTES ABOUT YOUR CAMPER’S STORE ACCOUNT:

- We recommend adding \$40-\$60 to your camper’s store account online to cover purchases and activities throughout the week.
- Campers cannot use cash at the Camp Store; they must use money in their store account.
- Any remaining balance will be returned to you the next week via credit card or check. You also have the option of donating the remaining balance to camp.
- You can check your camper’s balance while camp is in session and add money to the account online.
- If your camper needs money for the trip home, please pack it separately so it does not get mixed in with the store account at camp.
- Campers receiving a scholarship may not have more than \$25 in their store account.
